



## **NAVIGATING STUDENT LOAN UNCERTAINTY**

Steps you can take during the 2025 pause in Income-Driven Repayment applications & recertifications:		
	<ul> <li>STEP 1: Examine your studentaid.gov account</li> <li>✓ Review your contact information, confirm it is correct, update if needed</li> <li>✓ Grab any documents from your My Activity section in your studentaid.gov dashboard</li> <li>✓ Download your student aid data file (save as TXT file)</li> <li>✓ Look for an "IDR End of Payment Term" widget in your studentaid.gov dashboard</li> <li>○ If you see it, click the View IDR Progress button. Download a copy of your payment history using the new VIN Foundation Download My IDR Progress browser extension.</li> <li>○ If you do not see an "IDR End of Payment Term" widget, try entering the following URLs into your browser while logged in to studnetaid.gov:</li> </ul>

Take a snapshot of your PSLF/TEPSLF Payment Progress data on your studentaid.gov dashboard</li> </ul>	
	STEP 2: Gather student loan information from your loan servicer account	
	✓ Review your contact information, confirm it is correct, update if needed	
	✓ Download or request copies of statements, payment history, communications, etc.	
	✓ Check your repayment plan, monthly payment amount, and next payment due date	
	✓ Consider deactivating your autopay if you are unsure of your repayment plan or next payment amount	
	✓ Request a forbearance if your payment has recently increased and you're not sure why

Get student debt help from VIN and VIN Foundation  ✓ Visit VIN Foundation Student Debt Help page and follow instructions to receive student debt help for your specific loan situation  ✓ Explore the Student Debt Message Boards: research cases or post your own!  ✓ Do a good "Physical Exam" of your student loans on the Student Debt Center  ○ Upload your student aid data file to the VIN Foundation My Student Loans tool  ○ Check your repayment plan, IDR Anniversary Date, monthly payment amount  ○ Review your Income-Driven Repayment Eligibility and IDR Profile  ✓ Review recent VIN Foundation student debt blog posts  ✓ Listen to the recent Veterinary Pulse podcast
